Paper volume should not exceed 5 **pages** (A4, 210 x 297 mm in MS Word for Windows, rtf format, Times New Roman, font size 12, single line-to-line spacing, text margins 2.5 cm from all paper sides).

Report (materials) of conference sent to editors must be original and unpublished before in the other prints and contain research data at least for two years.

Editors keep the right to reject papers that do not satisfy the requirements stated above.

The maximum allowable size is 70 cm (width) x 120 cm (height).
